In February of 1964, local Woburn resident Gene English sent out a call to all interested artists and craftsman in the Woburn area. They all met at the historic Woburn Public Library and formulated The Woburn Guild of Artists. The Guild's first Art Exhibit was held on the lawn of the Woburn Public Library in May of 1964.

The purpose of the Guild is to promote an interest in the arts, to bring out the talent within its members and the local community, and to be recognized as a cultural group to whom the city of Woburn can point to with pride.

Membership is open throughout the year to anyone interested in the arts and related fields. Professionals, and Students, and Sunday painters alike, have always been welcome.

The Guild member's interests are applied in Watercolors, Oils, Acrylics, Drawing, Pastels, Carving, Sculpture, Computer Graphics, Mixed Media, Needlepoint, Handcrafts, and Photography.
